GC informed that the said property is depicted as part of contiguous pre-existing settlement area including 5 meter setback on land use land cover map of Maimollem Lake prepared by CSIR-NIO.

The Grievants were present in person and stated that is declared lease holder of plot bearing PT. sheet no.99 Chaltano11/1 &11/2 sub division 12, is legally designated as field by the government, wherein he practices agriculture but is facing difficulties due to ingress of sewage water. He further stated that paddy fields are not wetland as per Wetlands (Conservation & Management) Rules 2017 hence his area should be exempted from notification. He said that the currently the land belonging to the grievants is uncultivable due water pollution and the sewage water being accumulated in their agricultural lands, hence Government should take appropriate actions to restore the lands so the grievants can cultivate the land.

GC stated that agriculture is permitted activity as per wetlands (Conservation & Management) Rules 2017, and regarding pollution communication will be sent to GSPCB.

**Menino Henriques**



The Grievant was present in person and stated that is lease holder of plot bearing PT. sheet no.100 Chalta no.5/5, is legally designated as field by the government, and owned by Comunidade of Mormugao, wherein he practices agriculture and ready to take up agriculture and allied activities but is facing difficulties due to ingress of sewage water. He further stated that paddy fields are not wetland as per Wetlands (Conservation & Management) Rules 2017 hence his area should be exempted from notification. He said that the currently the land belonging to the grievants is uncultivable due water pollution and the sewage water being accumulated in their agricultural lands, hence Government should take appropriate actions to restore the lands so the grievants can cultivate the land.

**Mangala Krishna Raikar & Krishna Raikar**

The Grievant was present in person and holding plot bearing PT. sheet no.158 Chalta no.85(P) falling under wetland notification & has existing house in the said property.

GC stated that all the pre-existing rights & privileges are protected and repair/renovation of existing house is permitted with 5 meter setback subject to the permission from other concerned authorities and that the said activity does not affect the ecological character of the wetland.

**Sanjay Krishna Raikar & 47 others**

The grievant Sanjay Raikar was present in person and represented 47 others and placed grievance that there is fear and anxiety among the community regarding various restrictions and prohibition which are imposed by wetland notifications and need clarifications regarding same.

GC stated that all the pre-existing rights & privileges including cultivation are protected and repair/renovation of existing house is permitted with 5 meter setback subject to the permission from other concerned authorities and that the said activity does not affect the ecological character of the wetland. The grievant requested for ground truthing. Gc decided to refer the same to authority. The Grievant also needed clarification regarding new construction in buffer zone. However with regards to new construction in within 50 meter from the mean high flood level, GC decided to refer the matter to Authority.

**Sumana Gynappa Mutagi, Birappa Mutagi & Gyanappa Mutagi**



The Grievants were present in person and stated that Sumana Gynappa Mutagi, Birappa Mutagi owns property bearing PT. Sheet no.158 Chalta no.47 and Gyannappa co-owner of property bearing PT. sheet no. 158 Chalta no.16 and has existing house. GC stated that all the pre-existing rights & privileges including cultivation are protected and repair/renovation of existing house is permitted with 5 meter setback subject to the permission from other concerned authorities and that the said activity does not affect the ecological character of the wetland. Further the grievant intended to do new construction in the area notified as wetland. GC informed that the said property is depicted as part of contiguous pre-existing settlement area including 5 meter setback on land use land cover map of Maimollem Lake prepared by CSIR-NIO.

GC informed that agriculture pre-existing rights & privileges are protected & agriculture is also a permitted activity and repair and renovation of the existing structure with 5 meter setback is permitted subject to the permissions from other concerned authorities.

**Conclusion:** The Grievance Committee after hearing the grievances decided that it will direct GSPCB to check for water pollution and direct GWMC to act on initiatives to remove C& D Waste dumped. Further refer the matter of construction in 50 meter from mean high flood level to Authority. The GC informed that the pre-existing rights & privileges are protected and farming/agriculture is permitted activity within wetland notification. Those who intend to take up new construction within 50 meter from mean high flood level to the Authority for hearing. GC informed that the repair/renovation of the existing house is permitted subject to the permissions from other concerned authorities and also 5 meter setback is allowed wherein expansion of the existing structure is allowed also subject to the permissions from other concerned authorities. GC decided to that final decision regarding final notification to be taken by authority.

Further GC, while considering existing or proposed crematorium is for the community use and not for individual purpose and since it is permitted in other Wetlands namely Nanda Lake vide corrigendum dated 18<sup>th</sup> November 2021 hence the same needs to be decided in the case of Maimollem as pre-existing rights by the Authority.


**Agenda 2: Hearing for the grievants from Raia.**

A few grievants from 14<sup>th</sup> Grievance Committee meeting held to address the grievances received for Draft notification of Bacbhatt Lake and Bebki lake were permitted by Chairperson of GC to present their grievances in 17<sup>th</sup> Grievance Committee meeting day 2 held on 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2024. The **grievant from Raia** was represented by Adv. Afonso stated that the Raia Lakes do not qualify as wetland and should be relooked into by the authority also undue restrictions on new constructions in 50 meter from mean high flood level will cause hardship to the local community and cause gross economic losses. He also submitted written submissions. GC decided to refer the matter to authority for further decision.
