

The Goa State Wetland Authority is a regular authority designated for the identified activities for management and wise use of Wetland as identified under Rule 2 (b) of Wetland (Conservation and Management) Rules, 2017. The Authority shall further perform the functions specified by the Government of India from time to time which inter alia includes policy development, implementing regulatory frameworks integrated management planning and implementations etc.

The Technical Committee of GSWA, is constituted in exercise of powers conferred by Section 5, sub-section (6) of the Wetlands (Conservation and Management) Rules, 2017 to review brief documents, management plans and advise on any technical matter referred by the Goa State Wetland Authority (GSWA). The committee meets at least once in every quarter to perform their functions. Tenure of the Committee is for a period of three years.

The Grievance Committee of GSWA, is constituted in exercise of powers conferred by Section 5, sub-section (6) of the Wetlands (Conservation and Management) Rules, 2017 to provide a mechanism for hearing and forwarding the grievances raised by public to the Goa State Wetland Authority (GSWA). The committee meets at least once in every quarter to perform their functions. Tenure of the Committee is for a period of three years.
